## Georgia Department of Human Services Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

## SIMPLIFIED REPORTING REQUIREMENT (SRR) NOTICE

Simplified Reporting Requirements apply to all SNAP households in Georgia. You must report when your household's total gross monthly income is more than the amount listed in the chart below or provided on the blank below for your household size.

Households must report when a household member receives **lottery or gambling winnings**, in the gross amount of \$4500 or more (before taxes or other amounts are withheld). This is a cash prize won in a single game. The winnings must be reported no later than 10 days from the end of the month in which the household member received the winnings.

Able Bodied Adults without Dependents (ABAWDs) are required to report when their work hours fall below 20 hours per week, 80 hours monthly.

**Each month** you will need to **add up all the income** your household receives during the month, before any taxes or other deductions are taken out. You must count all income such as wages, Social Security, SSI, unemployment, child support, retirement and disability benefits; money people give you, and any other income your household receives.

When you add it all up, if it is more than the amount listed in the chart below <u>or</u> provided on the blank below for your household size, you **MUST** report the change in income by **the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the next month.**

If you fail to report this change, your household may receive more benefits than it is entitled to receive, and you may have to pay these benefits back. If you have any outstanding claims, your income tax refund(s) may be used to pay back these claims.

If you receive TANF, Child Care or Medical Assistance benefits, you must report all changes in your household circumstances within 10 days.

Report your address changes and any shelter and utility expenses so that you may receive important notices about your benefits. You can report this change on the Georgia Gateway website at <u>www.gateway.ga.gov</u>.
